Dear friends and colleagues of the Prosthodontics group of the IADR,

This year's 98th General Session & Exhibition of the International Association for Dental Research in Washington DC promises to be a special one! We hope to welcome all of you on one of the activities of the Prosthodontics Research Group.

In a few weeks, numerous participants from all over the globe will attend the conference to become updated on a huge variety of topics related to dental research, to exchange ideas, to establish collaborations, to meet old friends and colleagues, meet new ones, but also to celebrate 100 years of IADR. To honor 100 years of IADR, a symposium will be dedicated to the past and the future of prosthodontics (Mar 20; 8-9:30 am, CC room 143AB). Special attention will be given to evolutions in adhesive dentistry, removable as well as maxillofacial prosthodontics. Thanks goes to Dr. Kenneth Kurtz for organizing this symposium!

Our Prosthodontics Group accepted 147 abstracts, which will be presented on the upcoming meeting. There will be 7 oral sessions, 5 poster sessions, and 3 symposia. A special thanks goes to Dr. Lindsay Richards, our Group Programme Chair, for putting the program together. You can find an overview of our program at the end of this newsletter.

Again, a lot of original research will be reported. This makes it a unique forum for early career researchers to present their work. It is part of the Prosthodontics Group's mission to support these talented colleagues and to help them develop and excel. The Prosthodontics Group will therefore again award several grants.

The Arthur R. Frechette Research Awards in Prosthodontics honors the memory of Arthur R. Frechette who served as Secretary-Treasurer of the IADR from 1968 until 1977. The Frechette awards actually comprise an award for research undertaken with a materials science or bioengineering oriented protocol and another award for research undertaken with a biological sciences and tissue engineering oriented protocol. The awards are sponsored by the Prosthodontics Group of the IADR and supported by the Whip Mix Corporation.

The IADR Prosthodontics Group Pre-prosthetic Regenerative Science Award for Young Investigators (PPRS) recognizes original research by new investigators in the multidisciplinary field of pre-prosthetic or prosthodontics-related regenerative science, including, but not limited to, tissue engineering, bone, tooth and soft-tissue regenerative sciences, graft materials research, maxillofacial reconstructive biology and physiology and implant biological research. The awards are co-sponsored by the Prosthodontics Group and the Japan Prosthodontic Society.

The Neal Garrett Clinical Research Prize award recognizes clinically focused and patient-centered original research. The award recognizes the lifetime work of Neal Garrett and matches his efforts in patient care and is supported by Dr Sreenivas Koka and Premium Dental Editing LLC.

Dr. S. Rosenstiel is responsible for the Frechette awards, Dr. K. Sasaki and Dr. M. Kanazawa for the PPRS award, and Dr. F. Müller for the Neal Garrett award. Many thanks goes to the sponsors and to our officers for all the work to manage the awards! The winners of these awards will be announced on the Prosthodontics Group business meeting (Thursday 5-6 PM; CC room 158AB). We wish all candidates the best of luck!

Dr. M. Kern has done a very good job as editor of our website and Dr. D. Bartlett is gratefully acknowledged for his long lasting dedication to our group as secretary treasurer.
