Our Prosthodontics Group accepted 76 abstracts, which will be presented on the upcoming meeting. There will be 3 oral sessions, 6 poster sessions, and 1 symposium. A special thanks goes to Dr. Kenneth Kurtz, our Group Programme Chair, for putting the program together. Please read <u>his report</u> as Group Program Chair .

Again, a lot of original research will be reported. This makes it a unique forum for early career researchers to present their work. It is part of the Prosthodontics Group's mission to support these talented colleagues and to help them develop and excel. The Prosthodontics Group will therefore again award several grants.

The Arthur R. Frechette Research Awards in Prosthodontics honors the memory of Arthur R. Frechette who served as Secretary-Treasurer of the IADR from 1968 until 1977. The Frechette awards actually comprise an award for research undertaken with a materials science or bioengineering oriented protocol and another award for research undertaken with a biological sciences and tissue engineering oriented protocol. The awards are sponsored by the Prosthodontics Group of the IADR and supported by the Whip Mix Corporation. The competition for this award will take place Wednesday July 21st 8 AM EST.

The IADR Prosthodontics Group Pre-prosthetic Regenerative Science Award for Young Investigators (PPRS) recognizes original research by new investigators in the multidisciplinary field of preprosthetic or prosthodontics-related regenerative science, including, but not limited to, tissue engineering, bone, tooth and soft-tissue regenerative sciences, graft materials research, maxillofacial reconstructive biology and physiology and implant biological research. The awards are co-sponsored by the Prosthodontics Group and the Japan Prosthodontic Society.

The Neal Garrett Clinical Research Prize award recognizes clinically focused and patient-centered original research. The award recognizes the lifetime work of Neal Garrett and matches his efforts in patient care and is supported by Dr Sreenivas Koka and Premium Dental Editing LLC.

The PPRS award and the Neal Garrett award winners will be announced at the Prosthodontics Group business meeting (Tuesday, 13 July 2021, 4:00 - 5:00 PM EST). The Frechette award winners will be announced after the business meeting.

Dr. Stephen Rosenstiel is responsible for the Frechette awards, Dr. Manabu Kanazawa for the PPRS award, and Dr. Frauke Müller for the Neal Garrett award. Many thanks goes to the sponsors and to our officers for all the work to manage the awards!
